- Raymond S. Detor, Jr. currently owns and operates 5GO/Le Roy Airport that he purchased in 1994. It became a designated Privately-Owned Public Use Reliever airport for The Greater Rochester International Airport of Rochester, New York.in 1995.
- He purchased Le Roy Airport at a public auction in 1994
- Mr. Detor managed Ray Hylan School of Aeronautics, Inc. in Rochester, New York from 1974 to 1982 and subsequently was the owner from 1983-1986. The operation was a Part 141, VA-approved, New York State approved Flight School. In addition, Hylan Flying Service functioned as a Part 135 Charter Department. Between the two, 14,000 hours were flown a year. The fleet consisted of thirty-three aircraft that transported passengers and freight throughout the United States and Canada.
- Mr. Detor obtained his flight credentials for his first solo at 16, Private pilot's license at 17, and Commercial Pilot Certificate, Certified Flight Instructor Certificate, Multi-Engine Land, and Multi-Engine Sea Ratings at 18.
- Mr. Detor's career started at Ray Hylan School of Aeronautics at the age of 14 when he bartered as a line boy for flying lessons.
